## Trash/Recycling/Yard waste/Leaf collection reminders

Yard waste & Grass clippings will be picked up on Mondays. (season starts first Monday in April and ends last Monday in October) all yard waste or grass clippings should be placed in containers and should not exceed 50lbs. If trash is mixed with grass clippings or yard waste they will not be removed.

Branches And Brush must be tied in bundles weighing no more than 50lbs. If the quantity of yard waste is more than can be removed on Monday the process will resume the next day or on Wednesday on a bi-weekly recycling week. Plastic Bags for grass clippings are not acceptable

Scheduled Trash collection is Wednesdays. Waste Management is currently under contract for the removal of trash. If you have a problem or if you have a question they can be reached @ 856-412-4051. There is a 5 bag /5 can limit per household. A limit of 2 large items per household. If the items have glass the glass needs to be taped. Waste Management refuses to remove sofa beds, please call 931-0646 to make arrangements for pick up of sofa beds.

Heavy Metal & White goods collection on Wednesdays: (Refrigerators, stoves, wash machines etc.) Please call 931-0646 to schedule pick up

Mixed Stream Recycling is collected by-weekly on the west side of town on Tuesdays. containers not to exceed 50lbs.

Mixed Stream Recycling is collected by-weekly on the east side of town on Thursdays. containers not to exceed 50lbs.

## Snow Removal

The Public works Department would like to share some helpful hints that might make the removal of snow less frustrating to all. If possible do not park vehicles in street 1 hour after snow fall until 12hr after snow has stopped

If you have a driveway use it. If a car is in the street the plow has to leave a area that is not cleared to curb line approximately (3) times the car length. Please do not throw snow into street with shovels or snow blowers instead throw it back onto lawn areas. If possible wait

until borough trucks have stopped before you clear your driveway. The borough workers work hard to make driving safer and easier in snowy conditions. We thank you for your cooperation and look forward to providing this essential public service.
