

**JANUARY 30, 2024**

The Caucus Meeting of Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede was held on the above date in the meeting room of the Borough Hall, 24 N. Black Horse Pike, Runnemede, NJ. The meeting was called to order at 6:04 P.M. The following members were present at roll call: Mayor Kappatos; Council members: Passio, Kelly, Laubenstein, Cepero, Murray. Absent: Farrell; Present: Borough Engineer: Mark Basehore; Borough Solicitor: Daniel Long; CFO: Shelley Strehle.

STATEMENT: Mayor Kappatos read the notice of this meeting pursuant to the "Open Public Meetings Act."

**ITEMS DISCUSSED FOR FEBRUARY 6<sup>TH</sup> MEETING & NEW BUSINESS:**

**PUBLIC HEARING:** Ordinance 24-02 Calendar Year 2024 Ordinance to Exceed the Municipal Budget Appropriation Limits and to Establish a Cap Bank  
Ms. Strehle gave an overview of the ordinance.

**Used car lot applications for approval:**

Deputy Clerk confirmed all paperwork was in order for each lot.

**Sick time Payout:** Mayor Kappatos discussed the logistics of sick time payout, including state policy parameters, as well as how other local government handles it. Further discussion ensued as to how Runnemede can create a policy.

**Shared Service Agreement with Magnolia for CPWM**

**Authorization to Proceed with Bach Proposals:**

- CDBG Year 2023 Roadway Improvement Grant (2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Avenues)
- FY 2024 NJDOT Trust Fund (Williams/ Sherrington/ Mitchell): Mayor/ Council agreed to option number two in the proposal
- 2023 Local Recreation Improvement Grant (RYAA Baseball Field)

**Green Fair Event 4/21/24:** Ms. Kelly gave an overview of the Green Team event which include other Green Teams from neighboring municipalities. There was discussion regarding the logistics of the even and the importance of including an action plan with activity sheets. As there were still some details to confirm, finalized Mr. Long suggested presenting the event again once everything was finalized.

**6-Month Temporary Laborer Positions:** Mr. Wozunk discussed the need for qualified employees and that Public Works is seeking to replace 6-month temporary employees that have left.

Mayor Kappatos suggested passing appointment resolution immediately so that the new hires could start immediately.

**BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE**

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*A motion was made by Laubenstein, seconded by Passio that the resolution be adopted. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos requested a roll call vote with the following results: Ayes: Passio, Kelly, Laubenstein, Cepero & Murray. Nays: None. Absent: Farrell. Mayor Kappatos declared the resolution adopted.*

**Construction Fee Schedule:** Mr. Long confirmed that a new fee schedule was received and he was in the process of doing a comparison and the ordinance would be ready for first reading at the February 6<sup>th</sup> meeting. Mayor Kappatos reiterated the importance of redoing the fee schedule and how it affects the Borough when portions of fees also go to state.

### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

**PUBLIC EVENTS:** Council President Passio shared that February is Heart Health Month with February 2nd being wear red day. She gave statistics of heart disease. She requested everyone wear red at the 2/6 meeting and passed out pins.

**FINANCE:** Councilman Murray shared that he met with departments to get acquainted with everyone in his new role as councilman and finance committee chair.

**PUBLIC SAFETY:** Councilwoman Kelly discussed her tour of the firehouse and its completed construction improvements. She also shared her experience watching them get called out and how fast they responded. No Mow May was discussed.

**PARKS & RECREATION:** Councilman Cepero gave updates on RYAA sign-ups and the group's new website. Discussion ensued about the condition of fields, repairs made/ needed and grant options. The pickleball courts were also discussed.

**PUBLIC WORKS:** Councilman Laubenstein talked about the snow storm plowing and subsequent road damage. Mr. Wozunk explained the plan to patch roads.

**ENGINEERING:** Councilman Farrell was absent.

**PUBLIC WORKS SUPERINTENDENT:** Mr. Wozunk updated council on concrete work being done on sidewalks by American Fence – need DOT permitting and engineer assistance. He also said that the Harry Williams Building and Green Acres bathrooms, as occupied buildings, are deemed emergencies for the continuation of the repair/replacement of the fire alarm system being completed by Franklin Alarm. Ms. Strehle clarified that the PO's for those projects were already issued but the materials were delayed for so long that those buildings are still being completed.

Mr. Laubenstein mentioned the damage done by quads to the soccer fields during the snow storm. Mayor Kappatos said they needed to identify the individuals responsible and they needed to be cited and make restitution. Mr. Wozunk confirmed video footage was passed on to the police department. He also pointed out that the quads are running on the roadways making it unsafe to plow.

**SOLICITOR'S REPORT:** Mr. Long said anything he has was already discussed.

**BOROUGH ENGINEER:** Mr. Basehore went over his report with updates. Current and upcoming projects were discussed. Councilwoman Kelly had some additional questions regarding the sewer project and the pump stations.

**CFO/ FINANCE:** Ms. Strehle reported that the monthly and quarterly compliance reports have been filed. Annual Debt Statement will be filed 1/31/24 and the Annual Finance Statement is in progress.

Mayor Kappatos asked the solicitor for anything additional. Mr. Long said all was discussed.

Mayor Kappatos pointed out progress in Borough Hall with cleaning out for storage and new décor showcasing Borough history, groups and artwork.

**PAYMENT OF BILLS:** A motion was made by Passio, seconded by Kelly that the list of bills as submitted by the treasurer be approved for payment along with the monthly contractual bills when they become due. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos requested a roll call vote with the following results: Ayes: Passio, Kelly, Laubenstein, Cepero & Murray; Nays: None; Absent: Farrell; Mayor Kappatos declared the bill list approved.

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**GOOD & WELFARE:**

This portion of the meeting was open to the public.

Cathy Hornibrook, Borough of Runnemede, Green Team: Ms. Hornibrook asked about the following:

Appointing an assistant chairperson (Patti Adair) – agreed to appoint at the 2/6 meeting

Bike racks – Mayor Kappatos reiterated that location and pricing is needed – and said that as the town is improved there should be a theme to unite those improvements

Girl/Boy Scout building progress

Monthly Report – should the Green Team submit one to council. Mayor Kappatos suggested forwarding the Team's minutes.

Ms. Hornibrook read over the most recent Green Team meeting report. This included progress toward silver status for Sustainable Jersey and the appointment of the creative team. Mayor Kappatos asked about the status of their website. It was determined there was a conflict as to recovering the site and was referred to the Borough Solicitor.

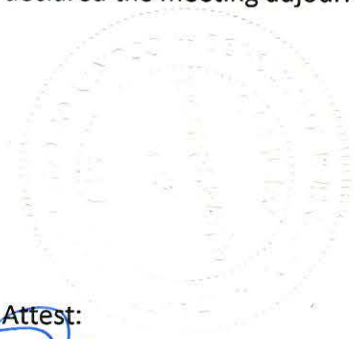

She said they would be partnering with Kyle Hanson (Mayor of Barrington) who has experience with this type of event. Mayor Kappatos requested a list of what they will need.

Seeing no one else wishing to speak, a motion was made by Passio, seconded by Laubenstein to close the good and welfare portion of the meeting. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos declared that portion of the meeting closed.

There being no further business to come before Mayor and Council at this time a motion was made by Laubenstein and seconded by Passio to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos declared the meeting adjourned at 8:03 PM.
