

MAY 1, 2018

The Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede was held on the above date in the meeting room of the Borough Hall, 24 N. Black Horse Pike, Runnemede, NJ. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. The following members were present at roll call: Mayor Kappatos, Council members: Passio, Laubenstein, Root, Kelly, Farrell & Ranieri. Absent: None; Present: CFO/Business Administrator, James D'Auria, Acting Borough Solicitor, Daniel Long, Borough Engineer Mark Basehore, Public Works Superintendent Harry Wozunk

STATEMENT: Mayor Kappatos read the notice of this meeting pursuant to the "Open Public Meetings Act."

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion was made by Ranieri, seconded by Passio that the minutes of the 3/27/18 & 4/3/18 meetings be approved as submitted by the clerk. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos declared the minutes approved.

REPORT OF CONSTRUCTION CODE OFFICIAL: No report filed.

REPORT OF BOROUGH TREASURER: (See Attached Report).

REPORT OF BOROUGH CLERK: A report was read reporting that the sum of \$1,929.80 was collected in various permits and licenses during the month of April, 2018. All fees were turned over to the Borough Treasurer.

REPORT OF CHIEF OF POLICE: A report was read reporting that the sum of \$139.12 was collected in Police, Accident, & Firearms Permits during the month of April, 2018. All funds were turned over to the Borough Treasurer.

REPORT OF REGISTRAR OF VITAL STATISTICS: A report was read stating the sum of \$3,450.00 was collected for death copies, burial permits and marriage copies during the month of April, 2018. All fees were turned over to the Borough Treasurer.

REPORT OF FIRE OFFICIAL: A report was read indicating inspections and activities during the month of April, 2018. Fees in the amount of \$8,082.23 were collected. Emergency Medical Services Billing for the month of March, 2018 was \$19,988.05. All fees collected were turned over to the Borough Treasurer.

REPORT OF TAX COLLECTOR: A report was read for the month of April, 2018 indicating a total of \$2,957,781.03 was collected in taxes and a total of \$46,561.34 was collected in Sewer Utility payments.



ORDINANCE #18-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER "NUISANCES" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED, by Mayor & Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey that Runnemede Borough Code Chapter shall be amended to ADD the following sections:

SECTION 1: Section Nuisances, shall be amended to ADD Article IV, Release of Balloons as follows:

Section Release of Balloons - Purpose and Intent. This article is adopted in order to protect the environment, particularly the wildlife, and the health, safety and well-being of persons and property by prohibiting the release of helium balloons into the atmosphere, including latex and mylar, as it has been determined that the release of balloons inflated with lighter-than-air gases pose a danger and nuisance to the environment, particularly to wildlife and marine animals so as to constitute a public nuisance and may pose a threat to the safety of its inhabitants and their property.


Section Prohibited Releases. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to intentionally release, organize the release, or intentionally cause to be released balloons inflated with a gas that is lighter than air within the Runnemede Borough limits, except for:

- (a) Balloon released by a person on behalf of a governmental agency or pursuant to a governmental contract for scientific or meteorological purposes.
- (b) Hot air balloons that are recovered after launching.
- (c) Balloons released indoors.

Section Violations and Penalties. Any person found in violation is guilty of a non-criminal infraction punishable by a fine not to exceed the sum of \$500.00.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication and in the manner provided by law.

7:00 o'clock P.M. at which time and place objections to said Budget and Tax Resolution for the year 2018 may be presented by taxpayers or other interested persons.






