CALENDAR YEAR 2019 ORDINANCE TO EXCEED THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION LIMITS AND TO ESTABLISH A CAP BANK (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14)

WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A:4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5% unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A;4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5% percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and members of Borough Council of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden finds it advisable and necessary to increase its CY 2019 budget by up to 3.5% over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and members of Borough Council hereby determines that a 1.0% increase in the budget for said year, amounting to \$67,767.27 in excess of the increase in final appropriations otherwise permitted by the Local Government Cap Law, is advisable and necessary; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and members of Borough Council hereby determines that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to the final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and members of Borough Council of the Borough of Runnemede, in the County of Camden, a majority of the full authorized membership of this governing body affirmatively concurring, that, in the CY 2019 budget year, the final appropriations of the Borough of Runnemede shall, in accordance with this ordinance and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.14, be increased by 3.5%, amounting to \$237,185.43, and that the CY 2019 municipal budget for the Borough of Runnemede be approved and adopted in accordance with this ordinance; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any that any amount authorized hereinabove that is not appropriated as part of the final budget shall be retained as an exception to final appropriation in either of the next two succeeding years; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance as introduced be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services within 5 days of introduction; and.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance upon adoption, with the recorded vote included thereon, be filed with said Director within 5 days after such adoption.

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING ENTIRETY OF BLOCKS 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29 AS A NON-CONDEMNATION AREA IN NEED OF REDEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et seq., the Borough Council may direct the Joint Land Use Board to conduct an investigation and public hearing to recommend whether certain areas of the Borough are in need of redevelopment pursuant to the procedures set forth at N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, the Borough Council on July 5, 2017 adopted Resolution #17-107 entitled "Resolution Authorizing The The Borough Of Runnemede Land Use Board To Conduct A Preliminary Investigation and Feasibility Study For Redevelopment of The entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29" thereby authorizing the Joint Land Use Board to conduct a preliminary investigation, hold a public hearing and recommend whether The entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29 as identified on the Tax Map for the Borough of Runnemede, or any part thereof, are in need of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the referral by the Borough, on or about July 2017 Steven M. Bach, PE, RA, PP, CME of Bach Associates confirmed with the Borough Council that the investigation should be undertaken as a non-condemnation determination of need study; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the referral by the Borough Council, Bach Associates, was authorized to conduct a study and prepare a report as to the proposed non-condemnation redevelopment area, the entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29 ("Study Area"); and

WHEREAS, on or about July and August, 2017, Candace A. Kanaplue, AICP, PP and Steven M. Bach, PE, RA, PP, CME of Bach Associates conducted an investigation and prepared a report entitled "Borough of Runnemede, Camden County, New Jersey, Preliminary Need Investigation Determination of Need Report, The entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29 " ("Study"); and

WHEREAS, the Study was prepared by analyzing the applicability of the statutory criteria under N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5 to the Study Area, the boundaries of which are set forth on a map prepared by Bach Associates, and contained with the Study; and

WHEREAS, after public notice required by law was published and mailed by regular and certified mail to the owners of property in the Study Area, the Joint Land Use Board conducted a hearing on February 13, 2019 to hear the comments of the public regarding the Study and the proposed non-condemnation redevelopment area recommendation; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2019 Candace A. Kanaplue, AICP, PP and Steven M. Bach, PE, RA, PP, CME of Bach Associates presented testimony at the public hearing regarding the findings and conclusions of the Study and concluded that the Study Area met the criteria for an area in need of redevelopment under N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(e) and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-3; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2019 members of the public, property owners and persons interested in the investigation were permitted to present testimony and objections regarding the investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Land Use Board considered the Study, the documents submitted into the record and the testimony and comments provided by all witnesses at the public hearing on February 13, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2019, the Borough of Runnemede Joint Land Use Board adopted Resolution No. 19-08 recommending that the entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29 be designated as a non-condemnation area in need of redevelopment, which Resolution is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution further incorporates by reference all exhibits, testimony, discussion, presentation, study and reports as well as the testimony taken at public hearing held on February 13, 2019 as though same were contained herein and set forth at length herein; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council has considered the Study and evidence presented to the Joint Land Use Board and the recommendation of the Joint Land Use Board that the entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29 be designated as a non-condemnation area in need of redevelopment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE RUNNEMEDE BOROUGH COUNCIL, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

- The Borough Council finds, consistent with the findings of the Joint Land Use Board, as follows:
 - a. The Study Area consists of entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29.
 - b. The Study area is located within the C Commercial, GO-General Office, R-1 Residential and P –Public districts, which are located along the Black Horse Pike Corridor between the New Jersey Turnpike and Clements Bridge Road (Route 41) and are predominately comprised of commercial properties along with apartments and single family residential.
 - c. Based upon the detailed property analysis in the Study, the findings of which are accepted and incorporated herein as if set forth at length, the findings of the Joint Land Use Board, and the presentation of Steven M. Bach, PE, RA, PP, CME and Candace A. Kanaplue, AICP, PP, the Study Area meets the statutory criteria set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(b), N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(c), N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(d), N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(e), N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(h) and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-3 for the designation of a non-condemnation area in need of redevelopment, including the following:
- (i) N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5.b. The discontinuance of the use of buildings previously used for commercial, manufacturing, or industrial purposes; the abandonment of such buildings; or the same being allowed to fall into so great a state of disrepair as to be untenable.
- (ii) N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5.c. Land that is owned by the municipality, the county, a local housing authority, redevelopment agency or redevelopment entity, or unimproved vacant land that has remained so for a period of ten years prior to adoption of the resolution, and that by reason of its location, remoteness, lack of means of access to developed sections or portions of the municipality, or topography, or nature of the soil, is not likely to be developed through the instrumentality of private capital.
- (iii) N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5.d. Areas with buildings or improvements which, by reason of dilapidation, obsolescence, overcrowding, faulty arrangement or design, lack of ventilation, light and sanitary facilities, excessive land coverage, deleterious land use or obsolete layout, or any combination of these or other factors, are detrimental to the safety, health, morals, or welfare of the community.
- (iv) A growing lack or total lack of proper utilization of areas caused by the condition of the title, diverse ownership of the real property therein or other similar conditions which impede land assemblage or discourage the undertaking of improvements, resulting in a stagnant and unproductive condition of land potentially useful and valuable for contributing to and serving the public health, safety and welfare, which condition is presumed to be having a negative social or economic impact or otherwise being detrimental to the safety, health morals, or welfare of the surrounding area or the community in general, N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(e), and
- (v) Although some of the properties in the Study Area may not satisfy a specific statutory criterion, they are being included because they are necessary for the successful redevelopment of the Study Area as a whole pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-3.

- 2. Based upon the detailed analysis in the Study and testimony before the Joint Land Use Board, the findings of which are accepted and incorporated herein as if set forth at length, the findings of the Joint Land Use Board and the presentation of Steven M. Bach, PE, RA, PP, CME and Candace A. Kanaplue, AICP, PP, the Study Area meets the statutory criteria set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5 for the designation of an non-condemnation area in need of redevelopment, including N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(b), N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(c), N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(d), N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(e), N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(h) and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-3.
- 3. Accordingly, based upon the detailed analysis in the Study and the findings of the Joint Land Use Board, The entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29, as identified on the Tax Map for the Borough of Runnemede, meet the statutory criteria to be designated as a non-condemnation area in need of redevelopment.
- 4. Therefore, the Borough Council determines that The entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29, as identified on the Tax Map for the Borough of Runnemede, should be and hereby are designated as a non-condemnation area in need of redevelopment, as provided in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5(e) and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-3.
- 5. The Borough Clerk shall forthwith transmit a copy of this Resolution to the Commissioner of Community Affairs, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6.
- 6. Within ten (10) days of the adoption of this resolution, the Borough Clerk shall further serve a notice of the determination of the Borough Council to designate The entirety of Blocks 40-52; 32-39; 21-23; 25; 27-29, as identified on the Tax Map for the Borough of Runnemede, as a non-condemnation area in need of redevelopment upon each person, if any, who filed a written objection thereto and supplied an address to which notice can be sent.
