AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF CHAPTER 50, ARTICLE I, SECTION 50-1 A

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede has recognized that the composition of the Police department should be amended; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede believes that it is in the citizens of the Borough of Runnemede to amend the existing ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede believes that public health, safety and welfare will benefit from this amendment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 50, Article I, section 50-1A shall be revised and amended to read as follows:

A. In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118, the Police Department of the Borough of Runnemede, hereby established, shall consist of the following members, not to exceed:

- (1) One (1) Chief of Police
- (2) Two (2) Police Captains
- (3) Three (3) Police Sergeants
- (4) Ten (10) Patrolmen
- (5) Such other police officers, including Class III officers, as the Mayor and Council may deem advisable to appoint from time to time.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
