The Caucus Meeting of Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede was held on the above date remotely. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. The following members were present at roll call: Council members: Passio, Laubenstein, Farrell, Kelly & Ranieri. Absent: None; Present: Borough Engineer: Mark Basehore; Solicitor Daniel Long, Superintendent Wozunk and CFO Greg Anderson.

STATEMENT: Mayor Kappatos read the notice of this meeting pursuant to the "Open Public Meetings Act."

#### **RESOLUTION #20-126**

## RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN INTERCHANGE AT EXIT 3 FOR DIRECT ACCESS ONTO ROUTE 42 IN THE BOROUGHS OF RUNNEMEDE AND BELLMAWR, CAMDEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY TO THE NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, there is a need to alleviate motor vehicle congestion along the Black Horse Pike (Route 168) in the vicinity of Exit 3 on the New Jersey Turnpike and the surrounding community; and

WHEREAS, after meeting with local elected officials about the traffic congestion, the representatives of the Fifth Legislative District have requested that the New Jersey Turnpike authority ("NJTA") review potential solutions for relieving the issue by directing some of the traffic towards a major highway, and away from local neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede supports the request made by the representatives of the Fifth Legislative District to the NJTA to examine alternate plans for Exit 3 as part of the planned lane expansion project; and

WHEREAS, this project will improve the ancillary issues that arise because of traffic incidents, local neighborhood quality of life issues, and roadway preservation problems due in part to the configuration of Exit 3 on the New Jersey Turnpike in the Boroughs of Runnemede and Bellmawr, in Camden County, New Jersey; now, therefore,

WHEREAS, the project will allow the New Jersey Turnpike Authority to construct an interchange at Exit 3 for direct access onto Route 42 in the above boroughs, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by Mayor & Council of the Borough of Runnemede that it does hereby support the request made by the representatives of the Fifth Legislative District to the NJTA to examine alternate plans for Exit 3 in order to help alleviate the long standing traffic congestion issues in the surrounding community.

## BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE

A motion was made by Laubenstein, seconded by Passio the resolution be adopted. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos requested a roll call vote with the following results: Ayes: Kelly, Ranieri, Farrell, Cepero, Passio & Laubenstein; Nays: None. Absent: None; Mayor Kappatos declared the resolution adopted. Mayor Kappatos also reviewed with council members what he found out about Exit 3 plans and maintenance when meeting various representatives.

A discussion ensued as to items scheduled to appear on the December 1, 2020 agenda as follows:

Public Hearings for Ordinances #20-12 and #20-13; Shared Service Agreements for trash collection, municipal court administrator services, mechanical repair of municipal vehicles and dog shelter agreement. Mayor Kappatos also discussed the introduction of an ordinance to set rates for police outside employment and a resolution authorizing easements for the expansion of our sewer system.

Councilwoman Passio spoke about the Fire Truck Parade on Sunday, November 29<sup>th</sup> beginning at 7 PM.

Councilwoman Kelly asked council if they had read the Penn plan. Mayor Kappatos stated that he would need to know the cost of each of the five choices before he could make any decision.

Councilman Farrell reported that the borough had received a DOT grant and that the light had been replaced near St. Teresa's.

Councilman Ranieri reported that the audit conference would be held next Monday and that council was conducting an audit of the Code Enforcement and Construction Department.

Councilman Laubenstein reported on storm draining cleaning, Christmas decorations being put up and that recycling would be collected on Friday (both sides).

Councilman Cepero reported that the sprinklers were being winterized and that the soccer lights had been returned. Rich also stated that he thought the field house should be closed.

### **NOVEMBER 24, 2020**

CFO Anderson reviewed the Best Practices survey with Mayor & Council and explained how he arrived at the answers.

Superintendent Wozunk asked about pickle ball and should he remove nets for the season. Everyone thought they should remain unless there is a problem. Harry also reported that he was changing the type of lock on the field house door.

Solicitor Long reported progress.

Borough Engineer Mark Basehore reported progress and stated he would rely on his written report. Mark also stated that the scout building plans were being drawn up.
