ORDINANCE #20-14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 50 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT"

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede ("Borough") is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, the Borough recognizes that there are times when police officers are sought for employment by private employers outside the scope of their regular duties and responsibilities for public safety reasons; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's Mayor and Council desire to establish procedures for the employment of off duty police officers to conform to the Fair Labor Standards Act, New Jersey Attorney General Opinions and statutory law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 50 of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, entitled "Police Department", shall be amended to add the following language:

Article VII- Off-Duty Employment

§ 170-11 Purpose

For the convenience of those persons and entities which utilize the services of off-duty law enforcement officers of the Runnemede Police Department and to authorize the outside employment of Borough Police while off-duty, the borough establishes a policy regarding the use of said officers.

- A. Members of the Police Department shall be permitted to accept police related employment for private employers or other entities only during off-duty hours and at such time as will not interfere with the efficient performance of regularly scheduled or emergency duty for the borough.
- B. Any person or entity wishing to employ off-duty police shall first obtain the approval of the Chief of Police, which approval shall be granted if, in the opinion of the Chief, such employment would not be inconsistent with the efficient functioning and good reputation of the Police Department and would not unreasonably endanger or threaten the safety of the officer or officers who are to perform the work.

§ 170-12 Escrow Accounts

- A. Any person or entity requesting the services of an off-duty law enforcement officer in the Borough Police Department shall estimate the number of hours such law enforcement services are required, which estimate shall be approved in writing by the Chief of Police, and shall establish an escrow account with the Borough Chief Financial Officer by depositing an amount sufficient to cover the rates of compensation and administrative fees set forth in this article for the total estimated hours of service.
- B. Prior to posting any request for services of off-duty law enforcement officers, the Chief of Police or his or her designee shall verify that the balance in the escrow account of the person or entity requesting services is sufficient to cover the compensation and fees for the number of hours specified in the request for services. The Chief of Police shall not post a request for services from any person or entity unless all fees and compensation required in the manner described in this section have been deposited with the Borough Chief Financial Officer. No officer shall provide any such services for more hours than are specified in the request for services.
- C. In the event the funds in such escrow account should become depleted, services of off-duty law enforcement officers shall cease and requests for further or future services shall not be performed or posted until additional funds have been deposited in the account in the manner prescribed in this section.
- D. The person or entity requesting such services shall be responsible for ensuring that sufficient funds remain in the escrow account in order to avoid any interruption of service.

§ 170-13 Request for Services

All requests to the Borough for services of off-duty law enforcement officers in the Borough Police Department for a period of one (1) week or longer shall be forwarded to the Chief of Police for posting at least ten days before such services are required. Any law enforcement officers, when so employed by the Borough, shall be treated as an employee of the Borough; provided, however, that wages earned for outside employment shall not be applied toward the pension benefits of law enforcement officers so employed, nor shall hours worked for outside employment be considered in any way compensable as overtime.

§ 170-13 Rates of Compensation; Payment for Service

Rates of compensation for contracting the services of off-duty law enforcement officers are established as follows:

Vendors-

\$105/hour.

Local and Regional Schools-

\$50/hour.

Churches and Other Non-Profit Organizations-

\$40/hour.

Municipal Government Agencies

\$75/hour

County Projects-

Current County Rate.

The minimum amount of time for these services is four (4) hours.

All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions Section 2: of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of the Section 3: Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect, as to this end the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication Section 4: as required by law.
