#### **ORDINANCE #21-02**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 395 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE ENTITLED "ZONING"

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede ("Borough") is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, the Borough seeks to update its current Ordinance pertaining to the Residence R-1 Zoning District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 395 of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, entitled "Zoning", shall be amended to add the following language:

#### § 395-6 Residence R-1 District

B. Size of lots. No residence or dwelling shall be erected or constructed unless the lot contains at least 6,000 square feet and has frontage of at least 60 feet. If a lot is on the bulb of a cul-de-sac, frontage shall be measured at the setback line, except present existing lots having minimum frontage of 40 feet and a minimum area of 4,000 square feet. All pre-existing lots that have residential structures built as of the date of January 1, 2021 and pre-existing lots that are larger than 50 percent of the other lots on the street shall be exempt from this requirement.

Section 2: All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of the Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect, as to this end the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
