AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY (BLOCK 149.02, LOT 23 AS SHOWN ON THE TAX MAP OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE) OWNED BY THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, NEW JERSEY, NOT REQUIRED FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13, ET SEQ.

WHEREAS, the Local Lands and Building Laws, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12-13, et seq., authorizes the sale by municipalities of any real property, capital improvements or personal property, or interests therein, not needed for public use by sale in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede is the owner of certain real property as further set forth herein ("subject property") not needed for public use, and the Mayor and Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to sell the same to generate revenue, reduce taxes and liabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement dated November 26, 2019 with the Black Horse Pike Regional School District Board of Education, a political board as defined by N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b)(1), respecting the sale of the subject property, subject to conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Runnemede in the County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:
