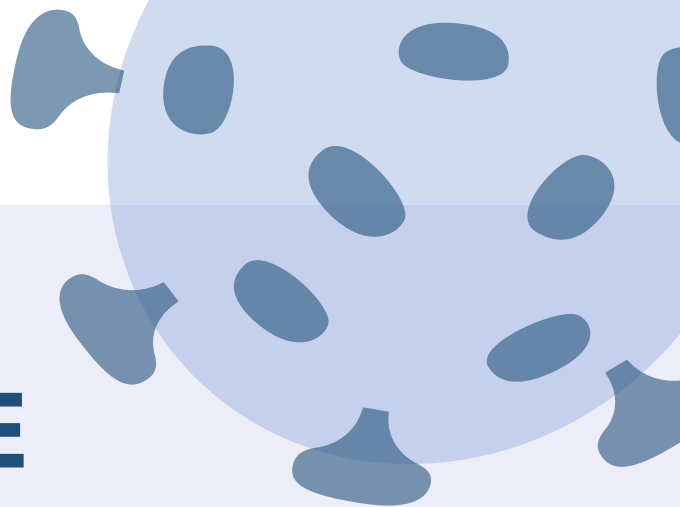


COVID-19 BOOSTER UPDATE



You must have received two doses of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine at least 6 months ago to be eligible for a booster dose

Who should get a booster dose?

- Age 65 or older
- Age 50 – 64 with underlying health conditions
- Long term care facility resident

Who may get a booster dose?

Individuals who meet the criteria below should consider their risks and the benefits of the vaccine when deciding whether to get a booster

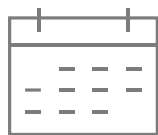
- Age 18 – 49 with underlying health conditions
- Age 18 – 64 whose job or living circumstances put them at risk for exposure to COVID-19

When should you get your Pfizer COVID-19 booster?



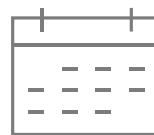
Dose 1
