WHEREAS, Phula, LLC has submitted a proposal to legally sell cannabis products at the retail level at a facility located at 312 North Black Horse Pike, Runnemede, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the proposal complies with all provisions of Ordinance #21-13; and

WHEREAS, cannabis establishments must be licensed by the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission requires applicants for licensure to provide proof of local support, which shall be demonstrated by a Resolution adopted by the municipality's governing body; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede desires to support Phula LLC's application to the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory Commission.

#### AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE, COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 395 ZONING DISTRICT TO INCLUDE SECTION 395-26 CANNABIS ESTABLISHMENTS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede ("Borough") is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, in 2020 New Jersey voters approved Public Question No.1, which amended the New Jersey Constitution to allow for the legalization of a controlled form of marijuana called "cannabis" for adults at least 21 years of age; and

WHEREAS, on February 22, 2021, Governor Murphy signed into law P.L. 2021,c.16 known as the "New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance and Marketplace Modernization Act" ("CREAMMA"), which legalizes the recreational use of marijuana by adults 21 years of age or older, and establishes a comprehensive regulatory and licensing scheme for commercial recreational (adult use) cannabis operations, use and possession: and

WHEREAS, the law establishes six specific types of cannabis related businesses that may be licensed by the state and allows each municipality to determine whether or not each of these types of businesses shall be permitted within their municipal boundaries

- Class 1: Cannabis Cultivator license, for facilities involved in growing and cultivating cannabis;
- Class 2: Cannabis Manufacturer license, for facilities involved m the manufacturing, preparation, and packaging of cannabis items;
- Class 3: Cannabis Wholesaler license, for facilities involved in obtaining and selling cannabis items for later resale by other licensees;
- Class 4: Cannabis Distributor license, for businesses involved in transporting cannabis plants in bulk from one licensed cultivator to another licensed cultivator, or cannabis items in bulk from any type of licensed cannabis business to another;
- Class 5: Cannabis Retailer license for locations at which cannabis items and related supplies are sold to consumers; and
- Class 6: Cannabis Delivery license, for businesses providing courier services for consumer purchases that are fulfilled by a licensed cannabis retailer in order to make deliveries of the purchased items to a consumer, and which service would include the ability of a consumer to make a purchase directly through the cannabis delivery service which would be presented by the delivery service for fulfillment by a retailer and then delivered to a consumer.

WHEREAS, CREAMMA Act authorizes municipalities to adopt by ordinance regulations governing the number of Cannabis Establishments, Cannabis distributors and Cannabis Delivery services, except for the delivery of Cannabis items and related supplies by a Cannabis delivery service based and initiated from outside of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede has determined that in light of the foregoing it is in the best interest of the Borough to adopt and implement this Ordinance that is in keeping with goals of the Master Plan and is in best interest of the Borough and health, safety and welfare of its residents and visitors;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden and State of New Jersey that:

Section 1. Amend Chapter 395- General Provisions Section §395-4- Definitions to include the following:

Cannabis - All parts of the plant Cannabis sativa and Cannabis indica, whether growing or not, the seeds thereof, and every compound, manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of the plant or its seeds, except those containing resin extracted from the plant, which are cultivated and, when applicable, manufactured in accordance with P.L.2021, c.16 (C.24:6I-31 et al.) for use in cannabis products, but shall not include the weight of any other ingredient combined with cannabis to prepare topical or oral administrations, food, drink, or other product.

Cannabis Business - Any person or entity that holds any of the six Classes of licenses established under P.L. 2021, c. 16, the "New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act." (CREAMMA)

Cannabis Cultivator - Any licensed person or entity that grows, cultivates, or produces cannabis, and sells, and may transport, this cannabis to other cannabis cultivators, or usable cannabis to cannabis manufacturers, cannabis wholesalers, or cannabis retailers, but not to consumers. This person or entity shall hold a Class 1 Cannabis Cultivator license.

Cannabis Delivery Service - Any licensed person or entity that provides courier services for consumer purchases of cannabis items and related supplies fulfilled by a cannabis retailer in order to make deliveries of the cannabis items and related supplies to that consumer, and which services include the ability of a consumer to purchase the cannabis items directly through the cannabis delivery service, which after presenting the purchase order to the cannabis retailer for fulfillment, is delivered to that consumer. This person or entity shall hold a Class 6 Cannabis Delivery license.

Cannabis Distributor - Any licensed person or entity that transports cannabis in bulk intrastate from one licensed cannabis cultivator to another licensed cannabis cultivator, or transports cannabis items in bulk intrastate from any one class of licensed cannabis establishment to another class of licensed cannabis establishment, and may engage in the temporary storage of cannabis or cannabis items as necessary to carry out transportation activities. This person or entity shall hold a Class 4 Cannabis Distributor license.

Cannabis Establishment - A cannabis cultivator, a cannabis manufacturer, a cannabis wholesaler, or a cannabis retailer.

Cannabis Establishment License- An establishment with one (1) or many of the licenses to operate as defined by the CREAMMA Act:

- Class 1: Cannabis Cultivator licerse, for facilities involved in growing and cultivating cannabis;
- Class 2: Cannabis Manufacturer license, for facilities involved m the manufacturing, preparation, and packaging of cannabis items;
- Class 3: Cannabis Wholesaler license, for facilities involved in obtaining and selling cannabis items for later resale by other licensees;
- Class 4: Cannabis Distributor license, for businesses involved in transporting cannabis plants in bulk from one licensed cultivator to another licensed cultivator, or cannabis items in bulk from any type of licensed cannabis business to another;
- Class 5: Cannabis Retailer license for locations at which cannabis items and related supplies are sold to consumers; and
- Class 6: Cannabis Delivery license, for businesses providing courier services for consumer purchases that are fulfilled by a licensed cannabis retailer in order to make deliveries of the purchased items to a consumer, and which service would include the ability of a consumer to make a purchase directly through the cannabis delivery service which would be presented by the delivery service for fulfillment by a retailer and then delivered to a consumer.

Cannabis Manufacturer - Any licensed person or entity that processes cannabis items in this State by purchasing or otherwise obtaining usable cannabis, manufacturing, preparing, and packaging cannabis items, and selling, and optionally transporting, these items to other cannabis manufacturers, cannabis wholesalers, or cannabis retailers, but not to consumers. This person or entity shall hold a Class 2 Cannabis Manufacturer license.

Cannabis Product - A product containing usable cannabis, cannabis extract, or any other cannabis resin and other ingredients intended for human consumption or use, including a product intended to be applied to the skin or hair, edible cannabis products, ointments, and tinctures. "Cannabis product" does not include: (1) usable cannabis by itself; or (2) cannabis extract by itself; or (3) any other cannabis resin by itself.

Cannabis Retailer - Any licensed person or entity that purchases or otherwise obtains usable cannabis from cannabis cultivators and cannabis items from cannabis manufacturers or cannabis wholesalers, and sells these to consumers from a retail store, and may use a cannabis delivery service or a certified cannabis handler for the off-premises delivery of cannabis items and related supplies to consumers. A cannabis retailer shall also accept consumer purchases to be fulfilled from its retail store that are presented by a cannabis delivery service which will be delivered by the cannabis delivery service to that consumer. This person or entity shall hold a Class 5 Cannabis Retailer license.

Cannabis Wholesaler - Any licensed person or entity that purchases or otherwise obtains, stores, sells or otherwise transfers, and may transport, cannabis items for the purpose of resale or other transfer to either another cannabis wholesaler or to a cannabis retailer, but not to consumers. This person or entity shall hold a Class 3 Cannabis Wholesaler license

Section 2. Adding §395-26 – Cannabis Establishment as Conditionally Permitted Use in Overlay Zone"

#### §395-26 Purpose and Intent

The purpose and intent of the Cannabis Conditionally Permitted Use in Overlay zone is to provide appropriate type of facility in appropriate location within the Borough while promoting economic growth that will preserve and maintain health, safety and welfare of the Borough and its residents.

§395-27 Conditional Use: Cannabis Establishments based on the type of licenses shall be permitted as conditionally permitted overlay zone in the following districts:

Class 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6	Special Economic Development (SED)
Class 5	Special Economic Development, Commercial,
	Redevelopment

#### §395-28 Conditions of Operation for Cannabis Establishments:

- 1. All Cannabis Establishments Class 1 through 6, located with the Borough shall meet all requirements for licensure and hold the appropriate license issued by the Cannabis Regulatory Commission, Department of Treasury, State of New Jersey.
- 2. No Cannabis Establishment shall permit on-site consumption of Cannabis or Cannabis related products including no on site sales and consumption of alcohol or tobacco products.
- 3. No outside storage of any Cannabis, Cannabis products or Cannabis related materials shall be permitted.
- 4. Hours of operation of any Cannabis Retail Facility shall be limited from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm, seven days a week.
- 5. For each Cannabis Establishment located within the Borough a security plan to be approved by Runnemede Police Department shall be provided to demonstrate how

the facility will maintain effective security and control of the operations. The plan should include the following but not limited to

- Type of security systems to be installed.
- Installation, operation and maintenance of security camera coverings all interior and exterior parking lots, loading areas and other such areas of the Establishments
- Tracking and record keeping of products and materials.
- Type of lighting provided in and around the establishments.
- Location on site security team and armed guard on premises.
- 6. Borough of Runnemede shall permit a maximum of 4 licenses Cannabis Establishments of any classification from Class 1 through 6. No more than 2 retail Cannabis Establishment Class 5 shall be permitted within the Borough.

#### §395-29 Conditions of Performance \$tandards:

- 1. All Cannabis Establishments, particularly Class 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5, shall provide detail information on Odor Control from these sites. This shall include Air treatment systems with sufficient odor absorbing ventilation and exhaust systems such that any odors generated inside the facility are not detectable are not detectable by a person of reasonable sensitivity anywhere on adjacent property, within public rights of way, or within any other unit located in the same building if the use occupies a portion of a building.
- 2. All Cannabis Establishments shall provide for noise mitigation features designed to minimize disturbance from machinery, processing and or packaging operations, loading and other noise generating equipment or machinery. All licensed facilities must operate within applicable State decibel requirements.
- 3. Loitering, disruption to/ and or obstruction of the free passage of persons or vehicles in immediate vicinity of the property shall be considered unlawful.

#### §395-30 Conditions of Site Development Standards

- 1. All Cannabis Establishment operations such cultivation, manufacturing, wholesale packaging and retail shall be conducted within a building. No operations shall be conducted outside.
- 2. Class 1, Class 2, Class 3 & Class 4 shall have minimum lot Area of 5 acres.
- 3. No Cannabis Establishments shall be located within 200 feet of house of worship, school, or day care.
- 4. Parking: Each Cannabis Establishment shall comply with the parking The following parking schedule shall be used to calculate the required number of off-street parking spaces per use. Where the calculation results in a fraction of a space, the required number of parking spaces shall be rounded to the nearest whole number.

Cannabis Cultivator – 1 per every 1,000 square feet of gross floor area or 1 per 2 employees at maximum shift.

Cannabis Delivery Service – 1 per every 1,000 square feet of gross floor area, plus 1 parking space for every delivery driver or fleet vehicle.

Cannabis Distributor – 1 per every 1,000 square feet of gross floor area

Cannabis Manufacturer -1 per every 1,000 square feet of gross floor area or 1 per 2 employees at maximum shift.

Cannabis Retailer - 1 per every 300 square feet of gross floor area

Cannabis Wholesaler - 1 per every 1,000 square feet of gross floor area

5. Signage: Signage shall comply with section Signs and Flagpole Regulations of the Land Use Ordinance.

#### §395-31 Cannabis Transfer Tax and User Tax

- 1. There is hereby established a Cannabis Transfer Tax in the Borough of Runnemede which shall be fixed at a uniform percentage rate of two percent (2%) on all sales or transfers of cannabis products from a Licensed Cannabis Entity, as defined herein, except for sales or transfers of cannabis products from a Cannabis Wholesaler, which shall be taxed at a percentage rate of one percent (1%) on all sales or transfers of cannabis products.
- 2. There is hereby established a Cannabis User Tax in the Borough of Runnemede at the same rates set forth in subsection (1) herein which shall apply to any Licensed Cannabis Entity which holds concurrent licenses and operates more than one (1) cannabis establishment. The Cannabis User Tax shall apply to the value of each transfer or use of cannabis or cannabis items not otherwise subject to the Cannabis Transfer Tax from the Licensed Cannabis Entity's establishments either without or outside the Township of West Orange.
- 3. The Cannabis Transfer Tax shall be in addition to any other tax or fee imposed pursuant to statute, state and federal law or local ordinance or resolution by any government entity upon a Licensed Cannabis Entity.
- 4. The tax imposed by this section shall be paid to the Borough on a quarterly basis no later than the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) day of the month following the last month of the quarter along with a report certified as true and accurate by the Chief Financial Officer, Controller or other similarly situated person showing the gross revenues for the Licensed Cannabis Entity for each month of the quarter.
- 5. The Licensed Cannabis Entity operating within the Borough shall file on an annual basis no later than February 1 of each year a financial report from an independent accountant certifying as to the annual revenues for the preceding year.
- 6. A copy of this Section shall be transmitted to the State Treasurer and to every Licensed Cannabis Entity within the Borough of Runnemede.
- Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that the Cannabis Establishment Ordinance conforms to the Master Plan of the Borough of Runnemede.
- Section 4. It is hereby found and determined that the Ordinance gives due consideration to the provision of appropriate allowable uses within the areas within Borough with special consideration for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the areas and the Borough of Runnemede.
- Section 5. In order to facilitate the implementation Ordinance, it is hereby found and determined that this action must be taken by Mayor and Council to amend the Borough of Runnemede Land Use Ordinance and take appropriate action upon proposals and measures designed to effectuate the same.
- Section 6. All Ordinances contrary to the provisions of this section of the Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent herewith.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication in accordance with law. ### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5, ENTITLED "BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede ("Borough") is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, the Borough seeks to amend Chapter 5 of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede to create a Façade Grant Program and Review Committee to review and decided upon Façade Grant Applications;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 5 of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, entitled "Boards, Committees and Commissions" shall be amended to read as follows:

#### Article IV Façade Review Committee

#### § 5-16 Committee Authorized

There is hereby authorize a Façade Review Committee which shall be appointed by the members of the Börough of Runnemede Mayor and Council to administer the Façade Improvement Grant Program.

#### § 5-16 Purpose

The Façade Review Committee will establish application guidelines and procedures and terms of conditions of grants so authorized. Grants awarded under this program are for exterior improvements only.

#### § 5-17 Eligibility Criteria

The following criteria must be met to be eligible for a Façade Improvement Grant:

- 1. Property owners of commercial or industrial buildings within the Zone.
- 2. Business owners or tenants of commercial or industrial zoned buildings within the Zone with property owner consent.

The following types of property are not eligible for funding:

- 1. Tax delinquent property within the Black Horse Pike Redevelopment Zone.
- 2. Property in litigation.
- 3. Property in condemnation or receivership.
- 4. Property owned by religious groups,
- 5. Property owned by 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations on which taxes are not being paid.
- 6. Exclusively residential buildings.

#### 7. Daycare centers.

#### § 5-18 Available Assistance

The Façade Improvement Grant Program will provide for a matching grant program, which shall generally be limited to \$5,000. When the circumstances permit, and pending the availability of funds, the Committee may increase the grant at its discretion, with the approval of Mayor and Council. A minimum private match of 100 percent (1:1) of the grant is required.

#### § 5-19 Application Process/Procedures

The application procedures and application review process shall be set by the Façade Review Committee.

A Façade Grant Program application shall be prepared and made available by the Committee. The final determination on grant applications shall be made by Mayor and Council.
