WHEREAS, the emergency services response activity to incidents continues to increase each year; Environmental Protection requirements involving equipment and training, and Homeland Security regulations involving equipment and training, creating additional demands on all operational aspects of the fire department services; and

WHEREAS, the fire department has investigated different methods to maintain a high level of quality of emergency and non-emergency service capability throughout times of constantly increasing service demands, where maintaining an effective response by the fire department decreases the costs of incidents to insurance carriers, businesses, and individuals through timely

and effective management of emergency situations, saving lives and reducing property and environmental damage; and

WHEREAS. raising real property tax to meet the increase in service demands would not be fair when the responsible party(s) should be held accountable for their actions; and

WHEREAS, Mayor & Council of the Borough of Runnemede or their designee desires to implement a fair and equitable procedure by which to collect said mitigation rates and shall establish a billing system in accordance with applicable laws, regulations and guidelines; Now, Therefore,

# BE IT ORDAINED BY MAYOR & COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE:

SECTION 1: Mayor & Council or their designee shall initiate mitigation rates for the delivery of emergency and non-emergency services by the fire department for personnel, supplies and equipment to the scene of emergency and non-emergency incidents as listed in "EXHIBIT A". The mitigation rates shall be based on actual costs of the services and that which is usual, customary and reasonable (UCR) as shown in "EXHIBIT A", which may include any services, personnel, supplies, and equipment and with baselines established by addendum to this document.

SECTION 2: A claim shall be filed to the responsible party(s) through their insurance carrier. In some circumstances, the responsible party(s) will be billed directly.

SECTION 3: The Mayor & Council or their designee may make rules or regulations and from time to time may amend, revoke, or add rules and regulations, not consistent with this Section, as they may deem necessary or expedient in respect to billing for these mitigation rates or the collection thereof.

SECTION 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of Mayor & Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in open meetings of Mayor & Council, and that all deliberations of Mayor & Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in accordance with all legal requirements, and the Codified Resolutions of the Borough.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall take effect at the date of adoption.

There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$680,000 (which amount represents Section 1. funds available in the Capital Improvement Fund of the Borough of Runnemede ("Borough")) for: (i) the completion of various road infrastructure improvements in and for the Borough, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor and related thereto, in the amount of \$375,000; (ii) the completion of various renovations to public buildings and facilities in the Borough, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor and related thereto, in the amount of \$50,000; (iii) the acquisition of various equipment for the Department of Public Safety and Emergency Management, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor and related thereto, in the amount of \$115,000; (iv) the acquisition of various equipment for the Department of Public Works, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor and related thereto, in the amount of \$20,000; (v) the completion of various improvements to various Borough parks and recreational facilities, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor and related thereto, in the amount of \$20,000; and (vi) the acquisition and installation of various computer software and equipment for various municipal departments, together with the acquisition of all materials and equipment and completion of all work necessary therefor and related thereto, in the amount of \$100,000 (collectively, the "Capital Improvements and Equipment").

Section 2. It is hereby determined and stated that the Capital Improvements and Equipment set forth in Section 1 are a general capital improvements and are not a current expenses of the Borough.

Section 3. The capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency therewith, and the resolution promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, is on file with the Borough Clerk and available for inspection.

Section 4. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication as required by law.
