Mayor Kappatos said they need to make a decision by either hiring someone or enter into an expanded shared service agreement with Barrington. A discussion ensued regarding options.

PAYMENT OF BILLS: A motion was made by Passio, seconded by Laubenstein that the list of bills as submitted by the clerk be approved for payment along with the monthly contractual bills when they become due. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos requested a roll call vote with the following results: Ayes: Laubenstein, Passio, Cepero, Farrell & Ranieri; Nays: None; Absent: Kelly; Mayor Kappatos declared the bill list approved.

GOOD & WELFARE:

This portion of the meeting was open to the public.

Cathy Walker, Borough of Runnemede: Confirmed ribbon cutting for All State on May 5th. She updated everyone on the community design program.

Linda Hurd, Borough of Runnemede: Ms. Hurd voiced her Concerns about Hirsch Lake and said she is appalled that people have dumped concrete and construction debris. She wanted to know if the RC Crawlers received permission for the obstacle course and who is condoning the use of piles of concrete. Mayor Kappatos said it would be discussed.

Seeing no one else wishing to speak, a motion was made by Laubenstein, seconded by Passio to close the good and welfare portion of the meeting. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos declared that portion of the meeting closed.
