#### **RESOLUTION #23-63**

### RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ADOPTION OF STRONG ANTI-IDLING POLICIES

WHEREAS, emissions from gasoline and diesel powered vehicles contribute significantly to air pollution, including greenhouse gases, ozone formation, and fine particulates; and

WHEREAS, numerous scientific studies have found links between exposure to fine particles and health effects including premature death, and increased incidents of asthma, allergies and other breathing disorders; and

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency has classified diesel exhaust as likely to be carcinogenic to humans; and

WHEREAS, asthma is a significant public health concern in New Jersey, especially among children (up to 25 percent of New Jersey's school-aged children are asthmatic) and the elderly; and

WHEREAS, the reduction of fine-particle emissions from diesel engines could also prevent 16,000 new asthma cases annually and save \$770 million to \$10 billion in health care and related costs in the state; and

WHEREAS, for every gallon of gas used, the average car produces about 20 pounds of carbon dioxide, the largest contributor to greenhouse climate change, with one-third of greenhouse gas emissions coming from the transportation sector; and

WHEREAS, petroleum-based gasoline and diesel fuel are non-renewable fuels and should be used wisely and not wasted; and

WHEREAS, idling is not generally beneficial to a vehicle's engine because it wears engine parts; and

WHEREAS, idling more than 10 seconds uses more fuel and emits more pollutants than turning an engine off and on again; and

WHEREAS, a car that is left idling can be easily stolen; and

WHEREAS, current state law prohibits the idling of vehicles for more than 3 minutes and studies have shown that an anti-idling policy will save fuel, prolong engine life, and improve air quality.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden and State of New Jersey support the adoption of a strong anti-idling policy by the governing agencies, schools, business and other organizations by:

- 1. Encouraging any gasoline of diesel powered motor vehicle to turn off the engines immediately at schools and off-site school related events to minimize exposure of children to vehicle emissions.
- 2. Maintaining municipal vehicles to eliminate any visible exhaust and complying with the annual inspection requirements for those vehicles.
- 3. Promote the widespread use of emission controls in construction contracts. For example, see the "Diesel Emission Controls in Construction Projects: Model Contracts Specifications" developed by the Northeast Diesel Collaborative.
- 4. Supporting broad education of the public about health, environmental and economic impacts, and ways to reduce idling.
