Mayor Kappatos stated the home owners would have to also deal with Barrington who owns part of the and also has liens on the property.

Ms. Funches, Runnemede: Ms. Funches asked about the progress on getting trees removed near her property. Mayor Kappatos explained he had offered our chipper to the owner of the property on which these trees are growing.

Cathy Walker, Runnemede: Ms. Walker told everyone she wants to hold another event in October. She also spoke about Runnemede businesses hiring interns.

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Seeing no one else wishing to speak, a motion was made by Ranieri, seconded by Farrell to close the good and welfare portion of the meeting. The motion carried and Mayor Kappatos declared that portion of the meeting closed.



ORDINANCE #23-05

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 230, SECTION 17
OF THE RUNNEMEDE BOROUGH CODE

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede ("Borough") is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 230, Section 17 provides that any variance granted by the Joint Planning/Zoning Board of Adjustment expires unless such permitted use has actually been commenced within nine months from date of entry of the judge or determination of the Joint Planning/Zoning Board of Adjustment; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede desire to repeal this provision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:


Section 1: Chapter 230, Section 17 of the Runnemede Borough Code is repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.







AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 50 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE ENTITLED "POLICE DEPARTMENT"

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede ("Borough") is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of the State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, the Borough seeks to update its current Ordinance pertaining to off-duty employment

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 50 of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, entitled "Police Department", shall be amended as follows:


§ 50-20 Rates of Compensation


C. The Borough holds the right to seek a third-party company for the Police Departments Off-Duty Employment Services for Off-Duty Program Administration. The chosen service provider may charge an additional fee other than the officer, administration or any other fees set forth by the Borough. This service may handle scheduling, billing, collections, pay or any other services previously performed by the Borough.

Section 2: All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of the Ordinance shall be declared invalid for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect, as to this end the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.





AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF RUNNEMEDE, COUNTY OF
CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 395
ENTITLED "ZONING"

WHEREAS, the Borough of Runnemede ("Borough") is a municipal entity organized and existing under the laws of State of New Jersey and located in Camden County; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede wish to amend the Ordinance to provide to increase the permissible size of a one-car garage in the Residential R-1 District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 395 of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, entitled "Zoning", Section 6, entitled "Residence R-1 District", shall be amended as follows:


§395-6 Residence R-1 District

- H. Private detached garages and other accessory buildings. No private detached garage or other accessory building exceeding 100 square feet in area shall be placed closer to a side or rear property line than five feet and should not be placed closer to the street line than 10 feet. Garages shall not exceed 18 feet in height. A one-car garage shall be limited to no larger than 400 square feet and 25 feet in size. In no instance shall there be an enclosed second story. Nothing herein shall prohibit the construction of a garage as part of or attached to the dwelling, in which event the side yard, rear yard, height and area requirements for the dwelling shall apply.

Section 2: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.






