The chosen service provider may charge an additional fee other than the officer, administration or any other fees set forth by the Borough. This service may handle scheduling, billing, collections, pay or any other services previously performed by the Borough.

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede wish to amend the Ordinance to provide to increase the permissible size of a one-car garage in the Residential R-1 District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Runnemede, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 395 of the Code of the Borough of Runnemede, entitled "Zoning", Section 6, entitled "Residence R-1 District", shall be amended as follows:

### §395-6 Residence R-1 District

H. Private detached garages and other accessory buildings. No private detached garage or other accessory building exceeding 100 square feet in area shall be placed closer to a side or rear property line than five feet and should not be placed closer to the street line than 10 feet. Garages shall not exceed 18 feet in height. A one-car garage shall be limited to no larger than 400 square feet and 25 feet in size. In no instance shall there be an enclosed second story. Nothing herein shall prohibit the construction of a garage as part of or attached to the dwelling, in which event the side yard, rear yard, height and area requirements for the dwelling shall apply.

Section 2: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
