2023 Summary Report of Internal Affairs Complaints

Possible dispositions of Internal Affairs complaints are:

2. **Not Sustained**: The investigation failed to disclose sufficient evidence to clearly prove or disprove the allegation.
3. **Sustained**: The investigation disclosed sufficient evidence to prove the allegation and the actions of the officer violated a provision of the agency's rules and regulations or procedures.
4. **Unfounded**: The alleged incident did not occur.
