He also confirmed that public works would be completing patch work on Oak Avenue as an interim fix until repaving can occur. Additional discussion ensued regarding stop signs and speed bumps.

Joe Catando, Runnemede: Mr. Catando also spoke about Oak Avenue, including sinkholes and curbing.

Anna Catando, Runnemede: Ms. Catando asked for clarification on the size of the patch (10x15) then stated that those patches would end up being the whole street. She said they paid to have a patch done when there were sewer issues and that patch is the only one still in good repair. She reiterated that the street is a disgrace.

Lynne McCausland, Runnemede: Ms. McCausland shared her story of identity theft in which she lost over \$200,000 to someone acting as an agent to the US Treasury Department. She wanted to thank the police department, specifically Sergeant Matt Woollen, for helping her through everything. She requested some sort of accolade for him. Ms. McCausland also thanked Patrolman Zimmer and Denise Streahle.

Seeing no one else wishing to speak, a motion was made by Laubenstein, seconded by Murray to close the good and welfare portion of the meeting. The motion carried and Council President Passio declared that portion of the meeting closed.
